RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT FOR STATE STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

The low bidder for the State Street Reconstruction Project is Wicks Construction of Decorah, Iowa, in the amount of \$664,010.83. Motion by Lighter, second by Esser that Resolution 06-26, **A Resolution Approving Bid and Awarding Contract for the State Street Reconstruction Project**, be adopted. On call of the roll the vote was all ayes. Motion carried.

APPROVE CHANGE ORDER #1- DIGESTER/MIXING SYSTEM PROJECT

Change order #1 is a reduction of \$16,178. Changes are cost reductions by contractor and engineer. Motion by Lighter, second by Kohlhaas, to approve Change Order #1 in the amount of \$16,178. On call of the roll the vote was all ayes. Motion carried.

APPROVE REQUEST FOR SEWER ADJUSTMENT

Diane Emerson of the Rose Garden Villa had a water leak. It was determined that the water did not enter the sanitary sewer system. Ms. Emerson requests that \$555.52 of sewer charges be forgiven. Motion by Kohlhaas, second by Von Ruden to adjust Ms. Emerson's sewer bill in the amount of \$555.52. On call of the roll the vote was all ayes. Motion carried.

ACCEPT RESIGNATION-BESCH

Andrew Besch has submitted his resignation from the Police Department. The Mayor and Council thanked Officer Erpelding for his years of service.

Motion by Kohlhaas, second by Weaver, to accept the resignation of Andrew Besch. On call of the roll the vote was all ayes. Motion carried.
