2012 ALUMNI BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

General Information

1. Player Eligibility

- a. Participants must have graduated from Algona High School or Bishop Garrigan High School. Men's teams may have a 3 year age span (example: 1999, 2000, 2001) and Women's teams may have a 5 year age span. BGHS and AHS graduates may also combine to form teams. One "Dads of Grads" and "Mom's of Grads" team will also be allowed to participate.
- b. In the event a class has more than one team a player may only play on one team.

2. Team Fee & Uniforms

- a. **Entry fee is \$140 per team payable at the time of registration.** A team roster must be submitted with the entry fee. All proceeds, after expenses, will be donated to the AHS & BGHS athletic booster clubs.
- b. All players **must** wear matching jerseys with numbers, preferably on both the front and back.

3. Divisions & Awards

- a. The men's tournament will be divided into age divisions if there are more than 11 teams. Women's format will be determined by number of entrants in each division. A double elimination format will be used for all divisions, however the format may be modified depending on number of teams entered.
- b. Championship T-shirts will be awarded to all members of the 1st place teams in each age division.

4. Players Rules & Conduct

- a. Team managers are responsible for the players on their teams. Unnecessary roughness, profane language, destruction of property or any other acts of unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated.
- b. Players will be ejected from the game after 2 unsportsmanlike technical fouls.
- c. Any player ejected from the game is also suspended from the remainder of the tournament.
- d. **Absolutely NO DUNKING before, during or after games. Penalty will be a 2 shot technical foul.**
- e. REMEMBER THIS IS A FUN, BENEFIT TOURNAMENT!

5. Building Rules

- a. ***No one is allowed on the gym floor and benches except players! The referees have expressed concern for safety with too many people in the gym. All spectators must sit in the balcony. Managers please make your players aware of this.***
- b. **NO SMOKING OR ALCOHOL ALLOWED ANYWHERE IN ANY OF THE BUILDINGS OR ON GROUNDS.**
- c. No food or drink is allowed in the gym or balcony. This also applies to spectators.

6. Scorers Table help needed

- a. Each team must provide 1 person **BEFORE** each of your games to help at the scorers table. We appreciate your cooperation with this.

Game Rules

1. Games will be played in **18 minute halves**. **The clock will run continuously for the first 16 minutes of each half, except for time outs, act of shooting fouls and intentional fouls.** The clock stops, as in a regular game, the last 2 minutes of each half and during this time all fouls will be 2 shots, except offensive fouls.
2. Each team is allowed **2 time outs per half**, 1 minute per time out. 5 minutes between halves.
3. Substitutions may be made at any time as long as it does **not** interfere with the normal flow of the game. Substitutions must be announced to the opponent when entering. Running players in to gain an unfair advantage will result in a two shot technical foul.
4. Five fouls, personal and technical, and a player is out of the game. Intentional fouls are 2 shots plus possession of the ball.
5. Alternate possession on jump balls. Jump 1st half and alternate after that. Only time you would re-jump would be for *overtime*. **1st overtime is 2 minutes, all succeeding will be 1 minute, clock stops for everything.** One additional time-out will be awarded to each team for each overtime, no carry over.
6. The **scorebook** at the official's table is final.
7. *Games may be played with 4 players.* A team that does not have at least 4 players to play five minutes after the scheduled start will forfeit the game.
8. **No dunking** at any time, this includes warm-ups. Penalty will be a two shot technical foul.
9. **Over and Back** line on all courts is the far free throw line.
10. **NEW IN 2012:** No jewelry is allowed to be worn which includes all rings and earrings.
11. Iowa high school boys/girls basketball rules will apply in all other situations.
